## Immigration Services

Accredited by Department of Justice to provide legal consultation to all immigrants, including naturalization, re-entry permit, green card renewal, and adjustment of status. Also provide free Citizenship/ESL Preparation Class to legal permanent residents. Appointment-only!

## Community Health Access Program

Our legacy program provides information, enrollment, and renewal support to individuals assessing government benefit programs and Covered CA. Toll free BAKI phone line provides community resource navigation M-F in Korean or other Asian languages with interpreters.

## Asian Community Wellness Program

A prevention and early intervention program funded by Alameda Behavioral Health Care Services addressing MH needs in the underserved East Asian community. Provide culturally responsive and trauma-informed services as well as access to community resources without insurance requirement.

### Counseling Services

Provide free counseling to East Asians of all ages living in Alameda county:

- Up to 12 months counseling;
- Wellness support groups;
- Community resources referral.

### Outreach & Education

Provide workshops tailored to your mental health and wellness needs. Offer easy access to educational materials in Korean, Mandarin, and English from our website and through our service providers.

### Mental Health Consultation

Provide an array of wellness seminars and training for partner agency staff and community leaders. Also provide on-site consultation and mental health screening.



### Case Management

Assist API seniors with basic quality of life issues by providing social services and wellness screenings. Also provide *Fall Prevention Class* and *Jikimee Leadership Program* to improve senior wellbeing and reduce stigma.
